

## Yowell & Masters Win '98 Leonard Kagan Design Fellowship

Jay Yowell and Louis Jay Masters, AIA, were named 1998 winners of the Leonard Kagan Design Fellowship, created and awarded by RTKL Associates Inc.

The fellowship offers two weeks paid educational leave and a \$2,500 stipend for travel, research and independent study in the recipient's chosen area.

Yowell will explore "Sustainable Aesthetic," a study of the aesthetics, forms and contextual responses of sustainable projects.

His research will take him to Germany and England, two nations that are largely urban, rich in aesthetic history and have strict environmental policies.
